Terry Wilshire and Bob Cutting were original builders of this aircraft and Terry was a driving force behind the establishment of Delta Airpark and Chapter 85. A few notes on the project are below courtesy of Sebastien Seykora:

*“Steve's aircraft is an 80% scale replica of a Supermarine Spitfire Mk V. The aircraft was based in Delta airpark for many years but was damaged in a forced landing after an engine failure after takeoff. It is being rebuilt with many improvements and will be a much closer copy of a real spitfire. Steve also sells plans and parts for the aircraft and says about 30 other people are building similar airframes.”*
